INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

- 1. The name of the school is St Andrew's CEVA Primary School
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Andrew's CEVA Primary School"
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) 1 Head Teacher
 - b) 2 parent governors (to be elected)
 - c) 1 LA governor
 - d) 1 staff governor (to be elected)
 - e) 7 foundation governors
- 5. Total number of governors is 12
- 6. Foundation governors are appointed by Peterborough Diocese Board of Education.
- 7. The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils and through the appointment of staff supportive of these values.

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Christian Church, through the Anglican Communion and in partnership with other Christian churches active in the locality and the Diocese of Peterborough, whilst respecting other faiths.
