

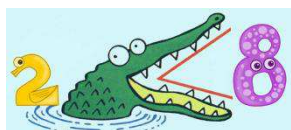
Year 2 Learning Log 12.10.18

Here is some information for you about what we have been learning about in Year 2 over the last week. There are some activities if you would like to do them with your child at home.

Maths

This week in Year 2 we have been exploring the less than symbol < and greater than symbol > in Maths.

We have used Charlie Crocodile to help us with this. Charlie Crocodile always eats the greatest/largest number.



For example- $2 < 8$. 8 is larger than 2 so the crocodile's mouth is wider for 8. The children have been using hand actions for Charlie Crocodile's mouth also.
